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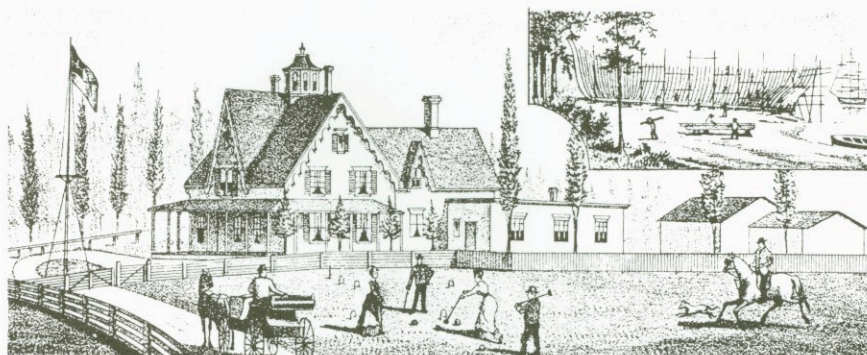
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## GREEN PARK

Throughout the 19th century the Island was the scene of extensive shipbuilding activity. In many coves and inlets ships were constructed to be sailed to all parts of the world. For Islanders it became an industry of great significance.

“Green Park” was the home of James Yeo Jr., whose family ranked among the leading shipbuilders of the last century. The house he constructed in the 1860s has been restored to reflect the lifestyle of its inhabitants during the prosperous shipbuilding era. Nearby an interpretive centre utilizes photographs and displays to describe the importance of shipbuilding and the various stages of ship construction. The re-created shipyard provides a further insight into shipbuilding and shipyard activities.
